Freestyle Devo Team is the first step on the development ladder for young freestyle skiers. This team is for skiers ages 8-14. Training takes place either Friday, Saturday or Sunday. Through the season our skiers benefit from a training progression taught by caring and responsible coaches who spread their knowledge and passion for skiing. Freestyle Devo Team skiers will build confidence and skills all over the mountain, while focusing on freestyle skills in moguls, aeriels and park. The fundamentals of solid skiing are introduced in the early part of the season usually outside of advanced terrain, but as the season progresses these fundamentals are tested in the various freestyle disciplines including moguls, aeriels and park events.. Athletes are encouraged to participate in our fun in house Freestyle Devo Competition Series. USSA license is not required for the in house competitions, but necessary for all USSA/RMD Youth Competitions.

Training schedule:

On-snow training from December 4 through March 28. Training is on Friday, Saturday or Sunday from 8:45 to 3:30pm.

Holiday training camp is December 26, 27 & 28 and is included in fees
