A competitive weekend freestyle program for skiers ages 13—19

***Freestyle Junior Team provides two days of training per week for freestyle skiers ages 13 and older. The team takes full advantage of its time on snow by blending free skiing skills with regular training in moguls and freestyle aeri-als. This team competes on the USSA Freestyle circuit in the Rocky Mountain Division Series in Colorado and USSA JO's if the athlete qualifies. Athletes looking for extra training opportunities should try our spring trampoline camps, summer water ramp camps, on snow camps and fall conditioning sessions.***

#### Competition schedule:

Will vary by age, ability, individual goals, and qualifications. Check with coaches for details. J2 & older athletes may need to purchase FIS license with USSA membership to attend FIS events. Event schedule is posted at [www.rockymountainfreestyle.com](http://www.rockymountainfreestyle.com)

#### Team travel:

Team travel for most of the away FIS, and RMD Freestyle events. These "travel comps" will be determined early winter. Winter Park vans are available to help with travel needs. Athletes traveling and lodging with the team must pay a \$300 deposit before the first travel event. Team Travel guidelines are outlined in the Competition Center Policies manual.

#### Training schedule:

On-snow training from November 21 through April 4. Training is on Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 to 3:30pm. Holiday camp December 27-31.

Program fees (before Oct. 15th):  
\$1775 for 2-days a week  
Includes coaching, a season pass, Competition Center membership, and ski locker.

#### Membership requirements:

⇒ USSA/RMD competitor membership required for RMD Freestyle Series  
⇒ FIS registration required for Nor Ams due Aug 15.  
USSA renewals due October 15, new members register before season starts.

#### Equipment needs:

- Mogul skis—separate skis for park, rock skis recommended for early season at the Jane and well-fitted boots (proper flex and fit very important)
- Helmets required for all training
